Correct info, and send spreadsheet back to <a href="mailto:lpinhq@lpin.org">lpinhq@lpin.org</a>.</li> <li>Begin to grow your facebook group or page.</li> <li>Make sure your CFA-3 is up to date with the IN Election Division and County Clerk.</li> <li>Hold a candidate training event with videos provided by LPIN. Invite Chris Spangle to attend.</li> <li>Buy OPH kit from <a href="http://theadvocates.org">theadvocates.org</a>.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Prepare a media kit, and personally deliver to members of the media.</li> <li>Work with County Clerks to obtain precinct maps.</li> <li>Use money raised to buy outreach piece (door hanger).</li> <li>Compile a list of local advocacy groups. (Tea Parties, Rotary Clubs, Kiwanis.) Call and invite yourself to speak.</li> <li>Begin holding house party/coffee fundraisers.</li> <li>Get Voter Data for district from Jack Evans. (<a href="mailto:jackevans@techie.com">jackevans@techie.com</a>)</li> <li>Price out yard signs. (Harcourt Industries is a good one.) Direct Mail Costs?</li> </ul>

Share emails and info with <a href="mailto:lpinhq@lpin.org">lpinhq@lpin.org</a> for Liberty Beacon lists.</li> <li>Obtain precinct maps from County Clerk.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Continue outreach efforts at local fairs. Collect as much data as possible! Share emails and info with <a href="mailto:lpinhq@lpin.org">lpinhq@lpin.org</a> for Liberty Beacon lists.</li> <li>Continue house party/coffee fundraisers.</li> <li>Begin walking targeted precincts crunched through voter data and precinct maps.</li> </ul>
October	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Continue outreach efforts at local fairs. Collect as much data as possible! Share emails and info with <a href="mailto:lpinhq@lpin.org">lpinhq@lpin.org</a> for Liberty Beacon lists.</li> <li>Recruit poll workers to pass out party literature. Ask all active members to take Election Day off. If all spots are filled all day, then fill out watchers.</li> <li>Coordinate with campaigns on GOTV efforts.</li> <li>Plan election night party. (Official LPIN party is in Indy at the Antelope Club.)</li> <li>Turn in CFA-4 before Noon 10-15-10.</li> <li>Facebook Ads for Candidates? Very Cheap and Targeted!</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Continue outreach efforts at local fairs. Collect as much data as possible! Share emails and info with <a href="mailto:lpinhq@lpin.org">lpinhq@lpin.org</a> for Liberty Beacon lists.</li> <li>Continue house party/coffee fundraisers.</li> <li>Continue walking precincts crunched through voter data and precinct maps.</li> <li>Recruit poll workers to pass out push cards stating your ballot number (ex. Dale Sombody, Vote D4!). Ask all volunteers to take Election Day off.</li> <li>Plan GOTV efforts.</li> <li>Turn in CFA-4 before Noon 10-15-10. (All candidates EXCEPT Federal Candidates and statewide candidates.</li> </ul>
